1 • Roman Catholic - Mansonville

This cemetery was originally some one-fourth of a mile to the west of its present site, on the road to Ruiter Book, Albert Jones had sold a piece of land, Oct. 8, 1882. The bodies were disentered and moved to the present site in 1925. It is well kept and in use.

2• Protestant Cemetery - Mansonville

This is the original site, it was incorporated in 1926, May 21st by order in Council is well kept and in use,

- 3 Chapel Hill Cemetery -Miltimore road Original site, is kept and maintained by Mansonville Protestant Cemetery, still in use.
- 4 Ruiter Settlement Cemetery -Dunkin Original site, Well kept and still in use.
